



St Edmund's College Summer School: Afternoon Classes

1. Introduction

All children attend afternoon lessons from 13:30 to 15:30, four days per week. Most of these are called *English Through Other Subjects*; the idea is that the children learn English through doing artistic, vocational or sports-based activities such as Drama, Food Technology or Tennis.

2. Optional Extras and Choose-on-Arrival classes

Some of the afternoon classes are chosen when you make an application and come with an additional fee; these are called 'Optional Extras' and have to be booked in advance. The other classes are chosen by the children when they arrive and are free of charge. On the evening when the children arrive, they choose their ETOS classes which are written down on their 'ETOS Passport' card that they keep with them. This is a sample ETOS programme:

Week 1: Food Technology (Optional Extra, pre-booked)

Week 2: Art

Week 3: Tennis
